### Seventh-day Adventists Believe

**The** Old and New Testaments are the written word of God.

**There** is one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit a unity of three co-eternal Persons.

**God** is the Creator, Source, Sustainer and Sovereign of all Creation.

**God** the eternal Son became incarnate in Jesus Christ.

**God** was active with the Father and the Son in creation, incarnation, and redemption.

**God** is Creator of all things, and has revealed in Scripture the authentic account of His creative activity.
